

AHNENTAFEL CHARTS

Ahnentafel is a German word meaning "ancestor table." The numbering on the chart is the same as that on a pedigree chart. The title person on the chart is number 1. His/Her father is number 2, and mother number 3. Any person's father may be found by doubling his number. For example, the father of number 2 is 4 or the father of number 123 is 246. The mother is double plus one, i.e., the mother of 123 is 247. The paragraph format of an ahnentafel chart is more compact than the pedigree style, allowing more information per page, full descriptions for all ancestors and an unlimited number of pages. Most computer genealogy programs will allow you to print ahnentafel charts automatically; many let you add notes and sources.
